This Sunday begins the season of Advent, marking the beginning of a new liturgical year. Advent is also a period of preparation and celebration of the Nativity of Jesus at Christmas. One of the traditions of Advent is the Wreath. This circular evergreen wreath usually contains 4 candles (sometimes 5), three purple and one pink, each one representing one of the Sundays of Advent. The first purple candle lit this Sunday represents **hope** or expectation of the coming Messiah.
