#### Dear Parents/Guardians & Carers

Next week we are looking forward to **the Art Show/Maths Night.** It is a wonderful opportunity for families to come and see all the fantastic work the children have been engaged in over the year. We thank Mrs Bruce, Ms Beeby and the Art Show Committee for all their hard work in co-ordinating this event for our school community. There is a barbeque set up for anyone wanting to buy a sausage and have their 'dinner' at school, eliminating the need to cook for one night (always a bonus!). If anyone can help with the barbeque please let us know. Mrs Viola has also put this up on Compass for everyone's information. Looking forward to catching up with you all next **Thursday evening from 4.00pm concluding at 7.00pm. The Halloween Family Disco is also coming up, this will be held on Friday November 1st from 6.30pm – 9.30pm.** Make sure to get your tickets so you don't miss out!

We have been made aware that a number of students are coming to school before 8.30am with a number of children arriving around 8.00am. It is important for families to understand that if students are at school they need to be under the supervision of an adult. The school's duty of care does not commence until 8.30am when staff begin their work day, therefore there is no teacher on duty to supervise. The Before School educators are not responsible for supervising the students that are not in their care and attending their session. **Students are not permitted to be at school before 8.30am unless under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian.** Should there be a need for students to come to school early, then they must attend the Before School program. This is a safety rule which needs to be taken seriously by everyone in the community. Please be mindful that children need to be kept safe at all times and both home and school need to work together to achieve this goal.

#### P.A. Meeting

The P.A. Committee met on Tuesday night to finalise details for both the Art/Maths night and the family disco as well as other school events coming up. It would be great to have some more members join this group. It is a great way to build connections and relationships within the community and support the school at the same time. #### Saint Teresa of Avila – Tuesday 15th October

During the 16th century, Teresa lived in an age of exploration as well as political, social, and religious upheaval. It was a time of turmoil and reform. She was born prior to the Protestant Reformation.

Teresa entered the Carmelites despite strong opposition from her father. She valued Prayer and the virtue of compassion. By leading a contemplative life, Teresa sought ways to be both practical and graceful.

Always thinking of others, she founded over a half-dozen new monasteries. She travelled, wrote, fought — always to renew and to reform. In her self, in her Prayer, in her life, Teresa became both inspirational and life giving to those around her.

Her writings, especially the Way of Perfection and The Interior Castle, continue to influence generations of believers.

In 1970, the Church gave her the title she had long held in the popular mind: Doctor of the Church. She and St Catherine of Siena were the first women honoured with this title.

Perhaps we can imitate Teresa's promotion of renewal within our modern Church. May we remember her legacy of Prayer as we courageously face the challenges we experience today.
